





Scale of 0 (not likely at all) to 10 (very likely)




Market Research Findings



Iowa's Population Growth



Federal Low-Income Housing Tax Credit Program

- Provides tax incentives to investors for the development, acquisition, and rehabilitation of income-restricted rental properties
- The investor incentive is the ability to claim tax credits on their federal income tax returns annually over a 10-year period
- IFA's Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP) details the allocation requirements, selection criteria, and housing priorities
- Awards are made annually highly competitive application process
- To date in 2023, IFA has awarded approximately
 - \$10 million to 11 projects to create or renovate 410 affordable rental units
 - \$1.56 million in the 4% program to 2 projects and 212 units

Workforce Housing Tax Credits

- Provides tax benefits to developers to provide housing in Iowa communities
- \$35 million allocation for FY 2024. Allocation is split equally between Small Cities and Urban areas
 - Small City: community in the 88 least populated counties or Community in the 11 most populated counties that meet both of the following criteria:
 - Population of 2,500 or less, based on 2020 census data, and
 - Population growth of less than 30% as determined by comparing census data from 2020 to 2010
- Maximum award for a project is \$1 million
- Housing development located on a brownfield or grayfield site
- Repair or rehabilitation of dilapidated housing units
- Upper story housing development (existing multiuse building)

Community Revitalization

Historic Preservation Tax Credits

 Encourages the sensitive rehabilitation and reuse of historic structures (e.g., schools, factories and hotels)

Redevelopment Tax Credits

- Tax credits to redevelop underused industrial and commercial property:
 - Brownfield Sites: Known or suspected environmental contamination
 - Grayfield Sites: Outdated infrastructure that prevents productive use

Downtown Resource Center

Helps communities learn about the importance of downtown development and how to make downtowns more viable

- Community Catalyst Building Remediation Program
 - Grants for redevelopment projects that stimulate economic growth and reinvestment in the community
 - 40% of funds must be allocated to cities with populations under 1,500
- Main Street lowa Recognized as one of the most successful state programs in the nation
 - Variety of services and training opportunities to build the capacity of local revitalization efforts in Main Street communities

Child Care Task Force Recommendations PARTNERSHIPS CHILD-STAFF RATIOS SHARED SERVICES BEND THE COST CURVE FINANCIAL INCENTIVES FOR BUSINESSES

- Over \$500 million invested in child care initiatives
- Increase in the number of 2-year-olds and 3-year-olds allowed in the care of an individual provider
- Child Care Management System
- 2,089 child care slots added since June 2022
- lowa Women's Foundation hired employer engagement director in partnership with IEDA
- Hamilton and Johnson counties launched wage enhancement programs to assist child care facilities cover wages and operating costs, the main barriers to fully staffed providers
 - Ten other counties/communities are in the process of establishing wage enhancement programs





Historic Tax Reform

- Tax Foundation ranking improvement of 31 places with full phase implementation of reforms
- Lowers corporate tax from 9.8% to 7.1% in 2024, with ultimate target of 5.5% by 2026
- Eliminated retirement income tax starting in 2023

Legislative Proposal

Reduce the personal income tax rate to a flat 3.65% retroactive to January 1, 2024. In 2025, the rate would fall to flat 3.5%.

Legislative Proposal: Unemployment Insurance Reform

lowa's unemployment tax rates currently rank 25th in U.S.

- Lower the maximum tax rate from 7% to 5.4% in all tax tables
- Reduce the number of tax tables from eight to four
- Reduce the tax table rankings from 21 to nine, effectively cutting overall tax categories from 168 to 36
- Save employers more than \$800 million over five years
