TOP 10 THINGS

TO KEEP KIDS BUSY IN WEBSTER CITY

- 1 Hike the Briggs Woods recreation trail system: bring the stroller and enjoy a scenic hike where you can see wildlife, water, and burn some energy.
- 2 Splish and splash in the outdoor Webster City pool in the summer or the indoor pool at Fuller Hall.
- 3 Lions Stafford Park has lots of fun equipment for the youngsters. They can practice some balance and there are musical features to some of the equipment pieces! They even have a wheelchair swing!
- 4 Exercise the kids and the dogs at Sketchley's dog park
- 5 Wehrheim Park offers a full court basketball court and plenty of room to run!
- 6 Engage their minds and imagination at Kendall Young Library. Downstairs is where all the fun activities for our youth are located. Their website is always up to date with activities!
- 7 At East and West Twin Parks you can explore large art displays and play on the equipment. They also have outdoor workout equipment you can utilize while watching the kids play.
- 8 Load up the bike and grab a picnic lunch and enjoy the 6-mile Boone River Trail
- 9 Need a shorter stroll? Then we recommend the Brewer Creek Trail which is a 2-mile loop that is scenic and easily accessible.
- 10 End the day enjoying a great live play or musical with local talent that might be happening at the Webster City Community Theatre!



PICK YOUR FUN!

Lions Stafford Park is a beautiful neighborhood park located on the west end of Webster City. This park includes a large green space for play, an inclusive playground, two swing set bays, a wheelchair accessible swing and a small basketball court.

Nokomis Park This sports complex has two softball fields, Carl Rhoer Ice Skating Rink, playground area, and canoe access. Visitors can access the Boone River trail via the trailhead right across the street. The park is backdropped by the historic quadrangular through truss bridge over Boone River to the North.

Ice Skating The Carl Rhoer Ice Rink is open when the weather allows from 5:00pm-8:00pm on weeknights and 1:00pm-8:00pm on weekends. Use of the rink is free, and dozens of skates are available to the public. The warming house and restrooms are open to the public while the rink is open.

Sledding Hospital Hill for the thrill! Known for the place to be when it snows, the hill fills with sleds, snowboards and lots of smiling faces and laughter as the young and old enjoy a ride on the powder.

Kendall Young Park, one mile north of Webster City, features White Fox Creek, offering a tranquil and peaceful environment surrounded by oak and hickory trees. Park amenities include: two horseshoe pits, a sand volleyball court, playground equipment, fishing access, public restrooms, Girl Scout Lodge, and three shelters available for rent, plus an open shelter overlooking the White Fox Creek.

WILDFLOWER TRAIL

The Wildflower Trail at Briggs Woods is a short trail by Shelter 2 that connects to the Woodland Trail. The trailhead sign reminds people not to take anything and just leave footprints behind. No flower picking is allowed. However, visitors can pick mushrooms, berries, nuts, and asparagus. You walk down into a deep ravine and walk up a very narrow trail that connects to the Woodland Trail that goes all the way to the Briggs Woods Park waterfalls. The trail is a moderately difficult walk. The trail is best known for having spring wildflowers at (April, May, and June) this time of the year, like May Apples, Blue Phlox, Blue Bells, Dutchman's Britches, Blood Root, Wild Ginger, Spring Beauty, Jack-in-the-pulpit, and Trout Lilies, along with a variety of other wildflower types.



BOONE RIVER TRAIL

The 10-foot-wide concrete trail is 6 miles in length from Webster City to the Briggs Woods Golf Course. This trail will follow the Boone River, under the railroad bridge and along Briggs Woods Lake in timbered areas. A beautiful and scenic walk or ride for your enjoyment. If people have physical limitations or are in a wheelchair or motorized wheelchair, the paved Boone River Bike Trail is their best option. It has wildflowers, trees, grand views of the park, the Boone River, woodlands, abandoned limestone quarry, artesian well, and Brigg's Woods Lake to enjoy.

JEWELSWORTH TRAIL

The Jewellsworth Trail is a short 3.5-mile trail between the communities of Jewell and Ellsworth. The trail travels along the abandoned rail line and enters into Jewell through a portion of timber. Jewell is known for its five different railroad companies that once used Jewell as a hub, giving its real name of Jewell Junction, Iowa.



WATERFALLS

Briggs Woods Park even has its own waterfall! A small creek connects to the lake and includes several waterfalls along the way. Visitors often skip the beach just to wade in the falls. To access the waterfalls, drive into Briggs Woods Park and follow the drive past the beach to the other side of the lake. There is a parking lot near the spillway. Come discover the hidden beauty of this local waterfall and the nature that surrounds it!

A TRULY "LITERAL" WONDER

Kendall Young Library, with its gold-marble columns, terrazzo and mosaic floors, stained-glass windows, and glass dome, is a hallmark of the Webster City community. Established through an endowment left by Kendall Young in 1896, Kendall Young Library completed construction and began operation in 1905.

Patrons have access to literacy programs, books, computer services, printing services, digital literacy classes, and a variety of special collections including the Abastenia St. Leger Eberle Sculpture Collection, the Jane Young Stained-Glass Window, The Foster Doll Collection, the Van Ness Native American Collection and more.

In 1932, the family of Wilson Brewer conveyed a nine-acre tract from the Brewer homestead to the City of Webster City in exchange for the promise to forever preserve the land, its buildings, and any subsequent additions in the name of the Wilson Brewer Park.

The City of Webster City accepted the Brewer family proposal and has owned and maintained the Wilson Brewer Park for 85 years. The park includes: Historic Log Cabins, Original Hamilton County Courthouse, Country School House, Mulberry Center Church, and the Illinois Central Railroad Depot.

EXPERIENCE EXTRAORDINARY

Kendall Young Library, built in 1896, is a treasure of the Webster City Community.

When Kendall Young passed away in 1896 the citizens of Webster City were surprised to learn that Mr. Young had left his estate valued at \$150,000 to the City of Webster City, in trust, "for the establishment and maintenance of a free public library."

The construction of the Beaux Arts style library was completed in 1905 at a cost of \$50,000. Special features included gold marble columns from Africa, terrazzo and mosaic floors, stained glass windows and a stained glass dome.

In 1984 a fundraising campaign was started to raise money for an addition to the library. After receiving two donations, each in excess of one million dollars and many smaller gifts, the architectural firm of Meyer, Scherer and Rockcastle was hired to design a seamless addition. Construction began in March 1997 and was completed in November of 1998.

The original library was 9600 sq. ft. and the expansion increased the size to 22,300 sq. ft. The beauty of the original building was maintained and stained glass windows and terrazzo floors were included in the expansion to enhance the appearance of the seamless addition.

The library is home to several special collections including Native American history, antique dolls, statues, and relics of the town's founding fathers.

Next door to the Kendall Young Library is the Jane Young House, the original home of Kendall and Jane Young. The historic home has been cared for by the Webster City Women's Club for 100 years. The home has been moved twice from its original location to accommodate the building of the library.

Kendall Young Library remains Iowa's only self-endowed library. Today the facility is sustained entirely via an endowment tied to Kendall Young's original endowment and private donations.
