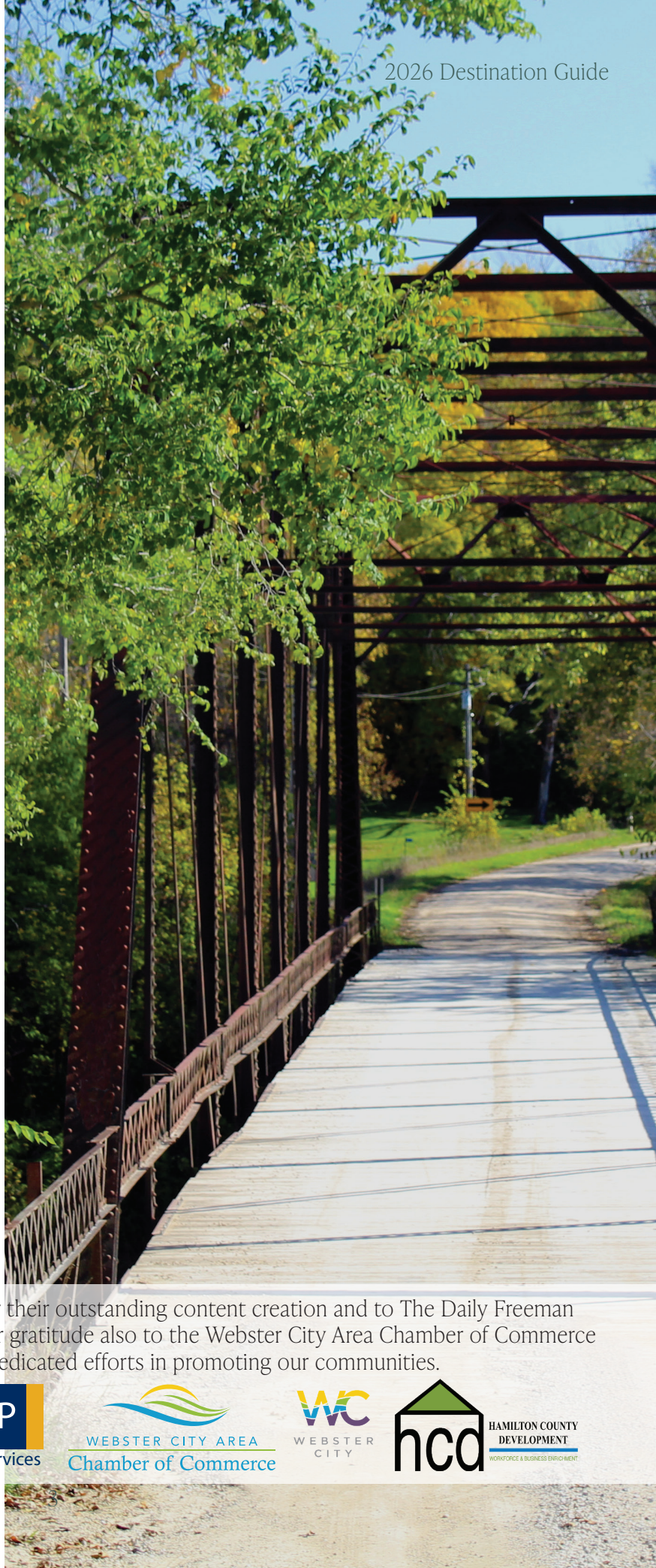

Twice the Fun

In addition to the splash pad, the parks offer playgrounds, skateboarding, and pickle ball & soccer court! PLUS, the Art Walk where families can see, touch and discover bigger than life sculptures that lead you on a walk of wonder!

Lions Stafford Park

📍 1304 Lynx Ave

A large green space for play, inclusive playground, swings, wheelchair accessible swing and a small basketball court.



Nokomis Park

📍 400 Des Moines St

This sports complex has two softball fields, Carl Rhoer Ice Skating Rink, playground area, and canoe access.



Kendall Young Park

📍 600 Kendall Young Road

Enjoy White Fox Creek, surrounded by oak and hickory trees.

Horseshoe pits, sand volleyball court, playground equipment, fishing and public restrooms. Shelters available for rent.



Brewer Creek

📍 1801 Des Moines St.

Sledding Hospital Hill for the thrill! Known as the place to be when it snows. The park also offers Frisbee golf, a paved walking trail, fire pit and shelter for gathering.



THINGS TO DO WITH YOUR CREW

- 1** Hike the Briggs Woods recreation trail system: bring the stroller and enjoy a scenic hike where you can see wildlife, water, and burn some energy.
- 2** Splish and splash in the outdoor Webster City pool in the summer or the indoor pool at Fuller Hall.
- 3** Lions Stafford Park has lots of fun equipment for the youngsters. They can practice some balance and there are musical features to some of the equipment pieces! They even have a wheelchair swing!
- 4** Exercise the kids and the dogs at Sketchley's dog park
- 5** Wehrheim Park offers a full court basketball court and plenty of room to run!
- 6** Engage their minds and imagination at Kendall Young Library. Downstairs is where all the fun activities for our youth are located. Their website is always up to date with activities!
- 7** At East and West Twin Parks you can explore large art displays and play on the equipment. They also have outdoor workout equipment you can utilize while watching the kids play.
- 8** Load up the bike and grab a picnic lunch and enjoy the 6-mile Boone River Trail
- 9** Need a shorter stroll? Then we recommend the Brewer Creek Trail, which is a 2-mile loop that is scenic and easily accessible.
- 10** End the day enjoying a great live play or musical with local talent that might be happening at the Webster City Community Theatre!

Boone River Trail

📍 North Des Moines St.
Webster City IA

The 10-foot-wide concrete trail is 6 miles in length from Webster City to the Briggs Woods Golf Course. This trail follows the Boone River, under the railroad bridge and along Briggs Woods Lake in timbered areas. A beautiful and scenic walk or ride for your enjoyment. If people have physical limitations or are in a wheelchair or motorized wheelchair, the paved Boone River Trail is a great option. It has wildflowers, trees, grand views of the park, the Boone River, woodlands, abandoned limestone quarry, artesian well, and Brigg's Woods Lake to enjoy.



Waterfalls

📍 2490 Briggs Woods Trail
Webster City IA

Discover the waterfalls at Briggs Woods Park! Hidden where a creek connects to the lake, visitors often skip the beach just to wade in the falls. To access the waterfalls, drive into Briggs Woods Park, follow the drive past the beach to the other side of the lake and park in the lot near the spillway.

Jewellsworth Trail

📍 936 Little Wall Lake Rd
Jewell IA

The Jewellsworth Trail is a short 3.5-mile trail between the communities of Jewell and Ellsworth. The trail travels along the abandoned rail line and enters into Jewell through a portion of timber. Jewell is known for its five different railroad companies that once used Jewell as a hub, giving it's real name of Jewell Junction, Iowa.



Wildflower Trail

📍 2490 Briggs Woods Trail
Webster City IA

The Wildflower Trail at Briggs Woods, a short trail by Shelter 2, that connects to the Woodland Trail. The trail head sign reminds people to **“take nothing but memories and leave nothing but footprints”**. Visitors can pick mushrooms, berries, nuts, and asparagus. A walk down a deep ravine and up a very narrow trail connects to the Woodland Trail, leading to the Briggs Woods Park waterfalls. Moderately difficult, the trail is best known for spring wildflowers including May Apples, Blue Phlox, Blue Bells, Dutchman's Britches, Blood Root, Wild Ginger, Spring Beauty, Jack-in-the-pulpit, and Trout Lilies.

Briggs Woods Park was the first county park in Iowa - with land donated to the people of Hamilton County in 1919, and preceded the state park system by one year!

The park consists of 544 acres, including campsites, trails, river access, playgrounds, a 62-acre lake, cabins, shelters and 18-hole golf course.

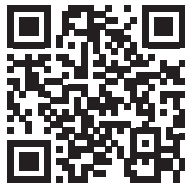

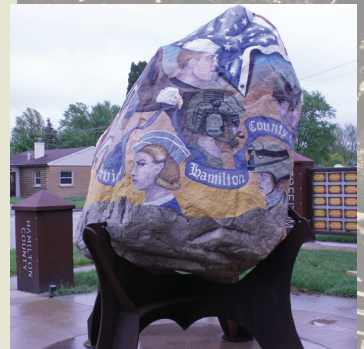

One Man's Surprise - A Community's Treasure

When Kendall Young passed away in 1896 the citizens of Webster City were surprised to learn that Mr. Young had left his estate valued at \$150,000 to the City of Webster City, in trust, "for the establishment and maintenance of a free public library."

Completed in 1905, the Kendall Young Library remains a treasure of the Webster City Community.

The Beaux Arts style library was completed in 1905 at a cost of \$50,000. Features included gold marble columns from Africa, terrazzo and mosaic floors, stained glass windows and a stained glass dome.

A successful fundraising campaign begun in 1984 allowed for a seamless addition completed in 1998. The library went from 9600 sq. ft to 22,300 sq. ft. maintaining the beauty of the original building.

The library is home to several special collections including Native American history, antique dolls, statues, and relics of the town's founding fathers.

Next door to the Kendall Young Library is the Jane Young House, the original home of Kendall and Jane Young.

Kendall Young Library remains Iowa's only self-endowed library. The facility is sustained entirely via an endowment tied to Kendall Young's original endowment and private donations.
